

Are YOU responsible?

Solomon Islands Fisheries Regulations say it is prohibited to...



Sell or expose for sale, buy or export any turtle or turtle parts or the product thereof.



Harvest turtles or turtle eggs, destroy or harm turtles, turtle eggs or turtle nests during breeding seasons of June to August and November to January.



Sell, buy or export any clam meat or the product of clams of the genus *Tridacna* and *Hippopus* harvested from wild.



Export any crocodile or crocodile skin or any part or the product thereof from the wild.



Sell, expose for sale, or buy any trochus shell under 8 cm and over 12 cm in diameter measured across the base.



Export any oyster shell of the genus *Pinctada* from the wild.



Sell or exposes for sale, buy or export any dugong or dugong parts or the product thereof.



Export any beche-de-mer or the product thereof from the wild.



Catch, retain, sell or expose for sale, buy or export any crayfish of the genus *Panulirus* whose carapace length is measured less than 8 centimeters; AND any female crayfish which is carrying eggs externally or from which the eggs have been removed.
